- Vehicle must be currently registered or have a pink temporary operating permit. One day trip/moving permits and PNO (Pending Non-Operation) permits <u>will not</u> be accepted.
- \$220.00 for a vehicle release fee. The Police Department only accepts cash, cashier checks and money orders. The Police Department <u>will not</u> make change.
